The Scientific Committee of the Conference reserves the right to review the abstracts and assign them as spoken papers or poster presentations. The basic criteria of qualifying the abstracts will be their academic value and relevance to the conference topics. Abstracts should not exceed a half A4 page.

The papers accepted for presentation during the conference (max 8 pp) will be published in the conference proceedings disseminated at the conference. The proceedings will be sent to the Conference Proceedings Citation Index - Social Science & Humanities (the Thomson Reuters ISI Index). If they are accepted, they will be available in the Web of Science database. Furthermore, the papers from Conference Proceedings are indexed in the Google Scholar.

It is also possible to publish an extended version of the paper after positive review in *Argumenta Oeconomica Cracoviensia*, *Cracow Review of Economics and Management* or *Entrepreneurial Business and Economics Review* in English (max 16 pp.)
